

Wreath Christmas Ornament

Abbreviations:

Dc = double crochet

Sc = single crochet

Slst = slip stitch

Recommended Hook Size: USH8/5.00 MM

Recommended Yarn: Lily Sugar and Cream; 100% Cotton, Medium Weight, Worsted 4 Ply

Materials: You will need a rubber hair band for this project. I use the 'ouchless' kind that doesn't have any metal clasp. It is best to use the thicker style.



Green

Join the yarn to the rubber band with a slst

Row 1: sc36 into the ring of the hair band (36) *Any multiple of 4 will work. If you can't fit 36 or if you still have a large gap showing, do the number of sc's that make sense. The hair band should be completely covered up.*

Row 2: (skip 1 sc, dc3 in next sc, skip 1 sc, slst1 in next sc)9 times (36)

Finish off.

Bow - using three strands of red yarn, about 20 inches long each, tie a bow the width of the wreath. Sew it onto the wreath using a strand of green yarn. Trim the tails of the bow to make them even.

This project is obviously extremely simple. It can be embellished with real ribbon, sequins, glitter, beads, or anything else you can think of. Ribbon or yarn can be weaved through the stitches to add color all the way around the wreath. Even though it is simple, it is still an adorable homemade gift. Maybe it could be used as the gift tag on your presents this year?
